## ST. PETER'S BELPER, Derbyshire

### GENERAL INFORMATION:

Belper is a small town situated on the banks of the river Derwent lying just over 7 miles north of Derby. Belper was once a chapelry of Duffield and in earlier times was part of the great forest of Duffield. An early occupation of the inhabitants was nail-making, but in 1775 Jedediah Strutt began to build cotton mills using the water power of the river and Belper's prosperity began. The population grew until Belper was considered the second town in the county.

The church of St. Peter was erected in 1824, but there is a register of baptisms dated from 1783, burials from 1794 and marriages from 1847. Included with Belper until 1819 is Heage and until 1846 Christ Church, also Cow Hill until 1913.

### EXPLANATION OF ABBREVIATIONS AND SYMBOLS:

The memorials have been copied verbatim, including epitaphs if any, and have been typed as such, except where the symbol / indicates a new line in the original inscription. The symbol ---- means that the letters, figures or words were unreadable. Those letter, figures or words which are underlined were difficult to read, but the transcribers think that the word, letter or figure recorded is correct.

### INDEXES:

The index of names refers to the reference number designated to each memorial, according to its position, and all named on each memorial are indexed, including Monumental Masons. The index of place names includes all houses, streets and towns mentioned on the memorials.
