GENERAL INFORMATION

The earliest historical mention as to the foundation of this chapelry is in the Parliamentary Survey of 1650, when in it is quoted under Duffield the mother church. In 1691 however, John Walker of Bradley devized in his will all the rest of his lands lying in Turnditch or Hazelwood, to William Hawford and his heirs, subject to the payment, amongst other charges of " 20s. per annum to the Curate or Minister of Turnditch Chapel." The building is of considerable age though, Early English, probably mid thirteenth century similar to that of the Chapel of St. John the Baptist, Belper another chapelry of Duffield.

The registers date from 1783, previous entries appearing in the registers of St. Alkmund, Duffield. These are very shortly to be deposited at the County Record Office, Matlock.

EXPLANATION OF ABBREVIATIONS AND SYMBOLS

The memorials have been copied verbatim, including epitaphs if any and have been typed as such except where the symbol / indicates a new line in the original inscription. Where the symbol - - - is used, those words or letters are eroded and therefore not decipherable. Immediately after each inscription is an indication of the form the memorial takes e.g. (S.H.) would mean that the memorial is a Slate Headstone. The following is a full list of abbreviations used.


INDICES

DERBYSHIRE




